Chocolate Key Lime Cupcakes Recipe

Ingredients:

- 12 jumbo-sized aluminum foil baking cups
- Vegetable cooking spray
- 1 (9 oz) package chocolate wafer cookies
- 1/2 cup butter, melted
- 3 (8 oz) packages cream cheese, softened
- 1 1/2 cups sugar
- 2 teaspoons key lime zest
- 1/3 cup fresh key lime juice
- 3 large eggs

Directions:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Place 12 jumbo aluminum foil baking cups in lightly greased muffin pans, and coat with cooking spray.

Pulse chocolate wafer cookies in a food processor 8 to 10 times or until finely crushed. Stir together cookie crumbs and butter; firmly press on bottom and two-thirds up the sides of each baking cup (about 3 tablespoons of crumbs per cup).

Beat cream cheese and sugar at medium speed with an electric mixer until blended. Add lime zest and lime juice, beating at low speed until well blended. Add eggs, one at a time, beating just until yellow disappears after each addition. Spoon mixture into prepared cups, filling completely full.

Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes or until set. Cool in pans on wire racks for 15 minutes. Remove from pans to wire racks, and cool completely (approximately 15 minutes).

Cover and chill for 4 hours. Garnish with whip cream and cherries.
